COMPUTER USE AGREEMENT

Science Computer Services gives users access to a wide variety of computer services. These include a variety of computers, software, and communications facilities. They are provided in a way that encourages collaboration between users. This places considerable responsibility on the individual users.

Many programs and other materials available through the computers in the facility are covered by copyrights, licensing agreements, or are proprietary information or trade secrets owned by organizations which have permitted them to be used in the facility. This frequently involves access to source code for various programs. In accepting a login the individual is agreeing to abide by the conditions of these copyrights, licenses, and other agreements. It is not possible to list all of these agreements here. It is the responsibility of each user to determine the relevant limitations before making copies of these materials for personal use.

- You are to use the facilities only for research and educational purposes related to City College and the City University.
- You are responsible for your login. Logins are granted to individuals for their use. They are not to be shared or turned over to another individual. Your password should not be disclosed to anyone.
- You may not circumvent system protection and security facilities.
- You may not knowingly cause system failure or degrade performance.
- You may not use the facility for private purposes, including, but not limited to, use for profit-making or illegal purposes.
- You are expected to be familiar with the regulations governing the use of the facility.
